For the completion of your project I have added up the entire project. Also we have broken down the cost to see where money was spent.

The project began on July 18th 2005 and continued through to September 29th 2005.
The restoration project consisted of.

Major re-framing
Complete re-fastening
Wedge seaming of bottom sides
Planking topsides (sheer)
Planking bottom side at the turn of the bilge (4 per side)
Garboard re-caulked
Spray rail
Mahogany rub rail at sheer
Hull rub rail with stainless steel strip
Re-fasten deck
Replace shaft, cutlass, seals
Replace rudder
Paint hull and bottom
Rebuild v-drive and footings
transom resurfacing and framing

All projects and purchases were considered necessary for the reconstruction of the boat.
The costs are as follows
